Day 1 Calgary (Wednesday) – We start our trip out by flying from Nashville to Calgary. A PASSPORT IS REQUIRED!! Upon arrival our motor coach will pick us up and take us to Banff where we will spend the next two nights at the Banff Springs Hotel. The hotel is a National Historical Site and located in the heart of Banff National Park. The construction of the hotel in 1888 marked the birthplace of tourism in the Canadian Rockies. D

Day 2 Banff (thursday) – This morning we tour the Banff area including Bow Falls, the Banff Gondola, Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner and the Hoodoos. There will be time to enjoy the downtown area of Banff on your own this afternoon. B

Day 3 Jasper (Friday) – Our travels today take us on the most scenic highways in the world as we travel the Columbia Icefields Parkway. As we travel we will have the opportunity to see a lot of wildlife. This morning we stop at Athabasca Falls and travel on to Jasper, where we have reservations at the Jasper Park Lodge, another Fairmont Hotel. This afternoon we have a boat ride on Maligne Lake, and the world-famous Spirit Island. B,D

Day 4 Lake Louise (Saturday) – Today will be one of the highlights as we travel to the Columbia Icefields, for our journey onto the ice, on the special snow coaches for the trip on the Atchabasca glacier. As we travel toward our lodging for the night we will stop at Bow Lake and Peyto Lake. Tonight we have reservations at one of the most beautiful spots in the world Lake Louise. We will stay at Chateau Lake Louise and enjoy a wonderful meal. B,D

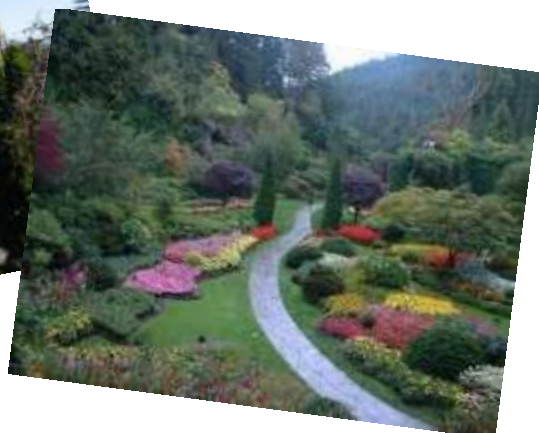
