## Nova Scotia

Thursday, October 4 – Wednesday, October 17, 2012  
Fly in Option: Sunday, October 7 – Monday, October 15

### Day 1 Staunton, VA (Thursday)

An early morning departure starts us on our exciting trip to Nova Scotia. Tonight dinner is included at Mrs. Rowes. D

### Day 2 Bird-in-Hand, PA (Friday)

### Day 3 Hartford, CT (Saturday)

### Day 4 Boston (fly-in option) (Sunday)

### Day 5 St. Johns, New Brunswick (Monday)

### Day 6 Nova Scotia (Tuesday)

The falls are created when the ocean rises upstream in the narrow gorge of the St. John River. We are scheduled to depart for Nova Scotia today at noon, with a three-hour ferry ride into Digby. Upon arrival we continue on to Halifax where we have reservations for the next two nights. Our hotel is within walking distance of the downtown shopping area. CB
