This morning, we board our motor coach and begin a tour to our nation's capitol. We'll sit back and relax as we travel to Staunton for the night. D

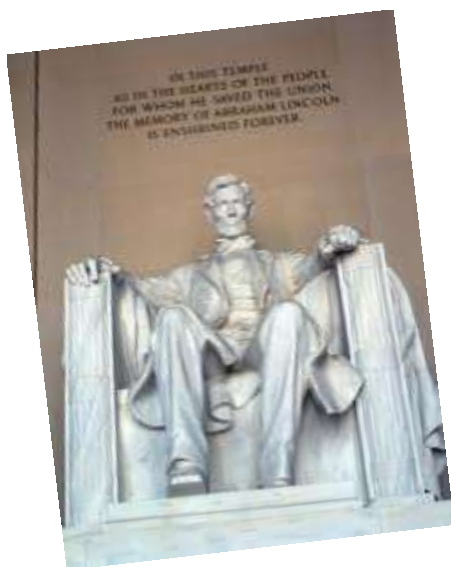
### Day 2 Washington (Tuesday)
