## SNOWMOBILING ADVENTURES

YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

Thursday, February 23 – Monday, February 27, 2012

### Day 1 Jackson Hole (Thursday)

This morning we fly to Jackson Hole, Wyoming, where we have reservations for night. Our motel is in the downtown area. Jackson Hole is a unique western town! There will be time to relax and get ready for tomorrow's early morning departure to Yellowstone.

### Day 2 Yellowstone (Friday)

Early this morning we begin our Yellowstone adventure. We will have a hot breakfast and get geared up with the outerwear provided for our snowmobiles, and then we will be transferred to Flagg Ranch to start our snowmobile excursion! We enter the South Gate of Yellowstone Park to Lewis Falls, West Thumb Geyser Basin. **We will travel along the west shore of Yellowstone Lake, North America's largest mountain lake – with stops at Dragon Mouth and Mud Volcano – to the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone.** At the Grand Canyon we will enjoy a light lunch and then we'll travel along the Gibbon River past Roaring Mountain and Obsidian Cliffs to explore the terraces at Mammoth Hot Springs. From there, we'll be shuttled to Gardiner for our overnight stay. B,L,D



### Day 3 Lamar Valley (Saturday)

It's another early start for an awesome snowmobile adventure! A wildlife tour of Lamar Valley by van with a guide begins our day, and if we're lucky we could catch sight of gray wolves on the hunt. After lunch it's back to Mammoth to continue our adventure in Yellowstone. We'll travel to Norris Geyser Basin for a stop, then continue along the Gibbon River and Madison River to the gates of West Yellowstone and into the town of West Yellowstone for the night. B,L,D

We'll ride to West Thumb, crossing the continental divide, and on to Flagg Ranch to be shuttled back to Jackson Hole for
