

Debit Card Safety: Travel Tips

Anytime you're planning a vacation, here are four WBT debit card safety tips that can help you stay secure and enjoy a worry-free trip. Happy travels!



1. Notify us of your travel plans

Due to fraudulent activity, at any given time, certain types of transactions may be blocked in specific areas or states. Unusual spending patterns may also be interpreted as a sign of fraud. Shortly before you go on a trip, please let the bank know that you plan to be away, and we can help you avoid potential snags with your card.

2. Know your card limits

Daily purchase and withdrawal limits apply to all cardholders, regardless of your balance. Contact your nearest WBT office to find out what these limits are.

3. Take only the cards you need

If you have multiple debit or credit cards and don't plan to use all of them during your trip, consider leaving them locked up securely back at home.

4. Be ready to stay in touch

If you have problems with your card while away from home, having quick access to the phone numbers below will allow you to get help from the bank or check our check card provider right away:

-For all card problems or lost/stolen cards **during business hours: (615)443-6105** -For lost or stolen cards **after business hours: (866) 546-8273**

Also, anytime your cell phone number or other contact info changes, be sure to let the bank know. Otherwise, we may not be able to reach you if we need to validate unusual activity or pass along important alerts.
