

CATEGORIES:

- 1. Large pieced machine-quilted: Made and quilted by one (1) person. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides measuring 281+" (inches).
- 2. Large pieced machine-quilted duet: Made and quilted by two (2) people. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides measuring 281+" (inches).
- **3. Medium pieced machine-quilted:** Made and quilted by one (1) person. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides measuring between 121-280" (inches).
- **4. Medium pieced machine-quilted duet:** Made and quilted by two (2) people. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides measuring between 121-280" (inches).
- 5. Small quilts or wall hangings pieced: Smaller than 120" (inches) of all sides. Made by one or two people. Techniques include pieced, applique, or a mix of both.
- **6.** Hand-Applique: All sizes made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 7. Machine-Applique: All sizes made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 8. Group quilts: Made by three (3) or more people. Includes all techniques. Progressive and Round Robin quilts included in this category.
- **9. Hand-quilted:** Quilts may be machine or hand pieced or appliqued but are quilted entirely by hand. Examples include whole cloth, hand embroidery, or combination of techniques. Any size, made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 10. Other techniques: Made and quilted by one (1) or two (2) people. Examples include whole cloth machine quilted, yo-yo, embroidered, heavily embellished, crazy quilts, and cathedral windows, general novelty, or combination of techniques.
- 11. Kit quilts or mystery quilts: Made and quilted by one (1) or two (2) people. May be composed of patterns, fabrics, and quilting designs packaged as a unit for resale. Includes panels and block of the month quilts.
- 12. Mixed Media/Art quilts: An art form that uses modern and traditional quilting techniques, using fabric, thread, paint to create designs. All sizes. Traditional pieced, modern/innovative, applique, and/or mixed fabric Quilts must be entirely original design.
- 13. Miniature quilts: A miniature quilt is a scaled down version of a large quilt with blocks no larger than four (4) inches. Any technique. Maximum size is 24" (inches) by 24" (inches). Fabric prints, appliques, and borders should be all scaled proportionately.
- **14. Youth/Rookie quilts:** First time entry in a quilt show. Any category or if person has been quilting less than two (2) years. Includes those who are 17 years and under.
- 15. Modern quilts: Quilts measuring 97+" (inches) total of all sides. A quilt featuring the design aesthetic of modern quilting. It may feature high contrasting colors, minimalism, improvisational peacing, negative spacing, and non-traditional layouts. Made by one (1) or two (2) people.



- **16. Wool quilted:** Item must have three (3) layers top, batting, and backing. Quilted by machine or hand and must be at least 50% wool on top layer.
- 17. Home décor: Pillows, tree skirts, table runners, or mats.
- **18. Treasure quilts:** Antique and Cherished quilts for **display** only.

Definition of quilting methods

<u>Hand quilted</u>: includes a series of running stitches made by hand through all layers of quilt with needle and thread without the use of a machine.

Embroidery machine-quilted: includes use of a programmable embroidery machine.

Other: includes any combination of quilting techniques or methods securing the layers of the quilt.

Art Quilt: any quilt made and intended to be used as a picture on a wall. An original design of the maker. Fabric/ material may be used in artistic or different manner. One person quilt only. Less than 61" (inches) on a side.

Stationary machine quilted: Use of a table mounted or stationary machine allowing the quilter to move the fabric to create quilting.

Movable machine quilted: Use of a movable machine rather than the fabric to create quilting.

Movable machine quilted-computerized: Use of a movable machine on a frame allowing quilter to program quilting to create quilting on fabric.

Quilt entry October 1 - 14, 2023. Quilts to be entered on-line through QR Code displayed. One entry at a time.

Quilts are brought to Wilson Bank & Trust Operations Center, 105 N. Castle Heights Ave Lebanon, TN 37087.





RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. Five (5) dollar per quilt entry fee for non-Peacemaker members.
- 2. Entry registration must be made by October 14, 2023. Entry is completed <u>on-line through QR Code</u> on flyer. Code available starting October 1, 2023.
- 3. Entries are brought to Wilson Bank & Trust Operations Center, 105 N. Castle Heights Ave, Lebanon, TN 37087 October 19 from 10 AM 3 PM. Registration may also be completed in person at that time.
- 4. All entries will be on display at Oktoberfest October 21-22, 2023, from 9:30 am 4:00 pm Oct 21 and 11 am-4 pm Oct 22, 2023, at Wilson Bank & Trust Operations Center, 105 N. Castle Heights Ave, Lebanon, TN 37087.
- 5. Ribbons are given for Best of Show, Viewer's Choice, & First Third place in each category.
- 6. The Lebanon Peacemaker Quilt Club reserves the right to refuse any entries deemed unsuitable for competition (soiled, pet hair, or smells of smoke, perfume, or pet odor will not qualify) and all entries will be displayed at their discretion. Entries not meeting requirements will be disqualified.
- 7. The entries remain the property of the owner, however, the Club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damages incurred during exhibition.
- 8. All entries must be picked up at the Operations Center no later than Monday, October 23, 2023, between 9 am 11 am.
- 9. Limit of one (1) entry per category per person.
- 10. All entries are professionally judged, unless submitted for display only.
- 11. All entries must have a label sewn on the back of the guilt bottom, left or right.
- 12. Large quilts will have a sleeve sewn on the back top.
- 13. Quilts entered are brought to Wilson Bank October 19, 2023, 10AM 3 PM. This includes both judged and display quilts.
