OKTOBERFEST QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES

BED QUILTS

1. Large piece machine-quilted: Made and quilted by one or two people. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides measuring 281+ (inches).
2. Medium pieced machine-quilted: Made and quilted by one or two people. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides measuring 121-280 (inches).
3. Small quilts pieced: Smaller than 120 (inches). Made by one or two people. Techniques include pieced, applique, or a mix of both.
4. Club Projects: Projects may vary, but include Mystery Quilts, Block of the Month, or Round Robin Quilts. Made and quilted by one or more people. Includes quilts totaling at least 120 (inches) of all sides.
5. Rookie/Youth Quilts: First time entry into a quilt show. Any category or if the person has been quilting for less than two years. This includes those who are 17 years and under.

WALL/ART QUILTS

6. Hand-techniques: Quilted entirely by hand. All sizes made by one or two people. Includes quilts that are hand pieced or appliqued. Examples include whole cloth, hand embroidery, or a combination of techniques.
7. Machine-applique: All sizes made by one or two people.
8. Art Quilts: An art form that uses modern and traditional quilting techniques, using fabric, thread, paint to create designs. All sizes. Traditional pieced, modern/innovative, applique, and/or mixed fabric. Quilts must be entirely original design.
9. Wool Techniques: Item must have three layers-top, batting, and backing. Quilted by machine or hand. Must be at least 50% wool on top layer.
10. Other Techniques: Made and quilted by one or two people. Examples include whole cloth, machine quilted, yo-yo, embroidered, heavily embellished, crazy quilts, cathedral window, general novelty, or combination of techniques. May be a combination of hand and machine quilting.

OTHER

11. Home Décor: Pillows, tree skirts, table runners or mats.
12. Display Only: Treasure quilts, antique quilts, or cherished quilts for display only.



Quilt entry October 1-16, 2025. Quilts to be entered on-line through QR Code displayed. One entry at a time. Quilts brought to Wilson Bank & Trust Operations Center, 105 N. Castle Height Ave., Lebanon, TN or during intake at First United Methodist Church; 415 W. Main St, Lebanon, TN.



RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Five (5) dollar entry fee per quilt for non-Piecemaker members to offset judging costs.
2. Entry registration must be made by October 16, 2025. Entry is completed on-line through QR code on Flyer. Code available starting October 1, 2025.
3. **All entries are brought to First United Methodist Church; 415 W. Main St, Lebanon, TN 37087 from 10 AM – 2 PM 10/14/25.** Registration may also be completed in person at that time.
4. All entries will be on display at Oktoberfest October 18, 2025, from 9:30 am – 4:00 pm October 19-2025, 11:00 am – 4:00 at Wilson Bank & Trust Operations Center, 105 N. Castle Heights Ave., Lebanon, TN.
5. Ribbons will be given for Best of Show, Viewer's Choice, Judge's Choice, and 1st-3rd place in judged categories.
6. The Lebanon Piecemaker Quilt Club reserves the right to refuse any entries deemed unsuitable for competition (soiled, pet hair, or smells of smoke, perfume, or pet odor will not qualify) and all entries will be displayed at their discretion. Entries not meeting requirements will be disqualified.
7. The entries remain the property of the owner, however, the Club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damages incurred during exhibition.
8. Limit of one entry per category per person completed within the last 3 years. Maximum of 3 judged entries.
9. All entries are professionally judged, unless submitted for display only.
10. All entries must be picked up at the Wilson Bank Operations Center no later than Monday, October 20th between 10 – 12 N.
