## CATEGORIES:

- 1. Large pieced machine-quilted: Made and quilted by one (1) person. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides equal to or greater than 288". No larger than 110" X 110".
- 2. Large pieced machine-quilted duet: Same as category one (1) but made and quilted by two (2) people.
- 3. **Medium pieced machine-quilted:** Made and quilted by one (1) person. More than 50% pieced. Total of all sides greater than 180" but less than 288".
- 4. Medium pieced machine-quilted duet: Same as category three (3) but made and quilted by two(2) people.
- 5. Small quilts or wall hangings pieced: Smaller than 180" made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 6. Computer-Driven Quilting: All quilts quilted by computer regardless of size.
- 7. Hand Appliqué: All sizes made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 8. Machine Appliqué: All sizes made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 9. **Group quilts:** Made by three (3) or more people. Includes all techniques. Progressive and round robin quilts are included in this category.
- 10. **Hand-quilted:** Quilts may be machine- or hand-pieced or appliquéd but are quilted entirely by hand. Any size. Made by one (1) or two (2) people.
- 11. Other Techniques: Made and quilted by 1 or 2 people. Examples include whole cloth, yo-yo, embroidered, heavily embellished, crazy quilts, and cathedral window.
- 12. **Kit quilts, mystery quilts, or quilts made in a class**: made and quilted by 1 or 2 people. May be composed of patterns, fabrics, and quilting designs packaged as a unit for retail sale, including panels and block of the month quilts.
- 13. Art Quilts: All sizes. Original design.
- 14. **Miniature quilts** these are not just small but must be on the right scale to separate them from the wall hangings. Any technique. No larger than 30" square.
- 15. Youth quilts includes quilts made by ages 17 and under.
- 16. Modern quilts: All sizes.

## **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

- 1. No entry fee.
- 2. All entries must be made on **Wednesday, October 12 and Thursday, October 13 from 9AM 1PM** at the Main Office of Wilson Bank and Trust at 623 W. Main St., Lebanon, TN 37087
- 3. All entries will be on display at Oktoberfest on Saturday, October 15 from 9:30AM until 4PM and Sunday, October 16 from 11:00AM to 4PM.
- 4. Ribbons will be given for first, second and third place. Ribbons will also be given for Best of Show and Viewer's Choice (voting on Saturday ONLY).
- 5. The Lebanon Piecemakers Quilt Club reserves the right to refuse any entries deemed unsuitable for competition, and all entries will be displayed at their discretion. Entries that do not meet requirements may be disqualified.
- 6. The entries remain the property of the owner, however, the Club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damages incurred during exhibition.
- 7. All entries are to be picked up at the bank on **Monday, October 17 from 9AM—1PM**. Any unclaimed quilts will be donated to charity.
- 8. Limit one (1) entry per category per person.
- 9. All entries will be professionally judged. However, some quilts such as antiques may be offered for display only.
